“Since I’ve Been Home” by Tore Price

My name is Tore Price and I wanted to let you know how I have been doing since being released from prison after 10 years on February 7, 2023.

First of all, I’m doing great and this could not have been the case without my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Friends, the work began while I was incarcerated. I needed to begin a transformation from a drug addict to a person in recovery and living in Christ. From developing a relationship with Christ, the parenting class I signed up for, visits with my son, Next Step Christian Recovery, NA, Inside Out Prison Exchange Program, being a tutor for Aioli’s II (food tech program at Macomb Correctional), to the countless other programs I participated in, I began a transformation.

Coming home already transformed allowed me to step into the spaces God had planned for me. I am currently employed. I have a full-time job and a part-time job with Temple University in Philadelphia as a training coach via zoom (training professors to bring Inside Out classes into prisons throughout the U.S. and the world) and I assist an Instructor at the University of Michigan with their class. I own a very nice car to get to all the places I go to and I have a massive support team.

The best part of coming home was being reunited with my 12-year-old son. We have been to two University of Michigan basketball games. I’ve been able to take him to baseball practice and I’ve been helping him get better on the basketball court. All the things I dreamed about and meditated on as I stood on Jeremiah 29:11:

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

My hope and future is now, and I am living in it.

I am thankful to many, one of whom is Ken of Northridge Church Prison Ministry and the One Day With God camps. The newsletters and the camps helped me get through some tough days on the inside.

God is truly good!
